Job Description for Regional Head

- 1. Leader of the Region in all respects. Hiring and managing members of the team. Leading Collections and Legal team for the region.
- 2. Overall owner of Collections target and cost of collections.
- 3. Set recovery targets in the hub region and formulate strategies to achieve the same.
- 4. Take daily updates from the collection personnel in all the offices in his control.
- 5. Formulate case-wise, location-wise, portfolio-wise collection strategies their effective implementation. Zonal Collection Manager in developing strategies to limit foreclosures, repossessions, etc.
- 6. Manage the re-possession and sale of assets from defaulters.
- 7. Develop collection agency infrastructure across the Region. Relationship driver with Collections, Repossession and Enforcement agencies. Strong vendor management and process orientation with hands-on experience.
- 8. Liaison with the legal personnel for recovery related issues.
- 9. Oversee and manage the functioning of the Managers in the Branches.
- 10. Lead portfolio acquisition DDs and providing accurate case information and assistance in pool/case evaluation.
